CAPE COD & BOSTON

SEPTEMBER 17 – 23, 2022

Day 1: Saturday September 17, 2022 – New York

Today we depart for our Cape Cod & Boston Adventure! After boarding the coach at your pre-selected pickup point, we will cross the border into New York State and make our way to Albany where we will stop for the evening. Dinner is on your own.

Day 2: Sunday September 18, 2022 – Cape Cod (B/D)

Enjoy an included breakfast before we depart for the sandy shores of Cape Cod! A local guide will meet us just before lunch (on your own) in a town called, Sandwich – the oldest town in Cape Cod! After lunch, we will head out for a guided tour which will include a view of the Great Salt Marsh, a local Cranberry bog, and Cape Cod Bay on your way to Hyannis. In Hyannis you will get to see the John F. Kennedy Memorial, the Korean War Memorial, Hyannisport and St. Francis Xavier Church - the summer parish of the Kennedy Family. After a long day we will check into the Holiday Inn Hyannis and enjoy an included dinner.

Day 3: Monday September 19, 2022 – Woods Hole (B/D)

Enjoy an included Breakfast and then meet your local guide in the lobby for a full day of exploring Woods Hole - home to the center of discovery of the HMS Titanic, the world-renowned Woods Hole Oceanographic Institution and the national headquarters of the international wildfire coalition. Hop onto the Steamship Authority Ferry to the Island of Martha's Vineyard and enjoy a tour with our local guide. There will be free time for lunch in the historic whaling town of Egartown. Complete your day on the island in Oak Bluffs strolling through "Cottage City" with its brightly painted cottages and decorative "gingerbread" trim. Dinner is included in the evening!

Day 4: Tuesday September 20, 2022 - Nantucket Island (B/D)

This morning we will meet our local guide and depart for a day of exploring on Nantucket Island! Upon arrival you will be shown different restaurants, galleries, shops and museums that are within walking distance of the dock. Lunch and Shopping will be on your own this afternoon. In the late afternoon we will depart the island and head back to the hotel for an included dinner.

Day 5: Wednesday September 21, 2022 – Cape Cod (B/D)

After breakfast our local guide will be waiting for us in the lobby for a full day of touring. We will travel the historic route 6A - a scenic byway winding through centuries of Cape Cod's history. View a Windmill, a Cape Cod Lighthouse and visit the Cape Cod National Seashore Visitors Centre; lunch will be on your own this afternoon. We will then board a vessel for an amazing whale watching experience! Try to spot Humpback, Mike, and Fin whales going about their daily business. If you do not want to participate in this excursion you can opt to stay on land with a Dune Tour through the protected lands of the Cape Cod National Seashore.

Day 6: Thursday September 22, 2022 – Boston (B/D)

This morning we will travel to Boston and explore the city where America's roots were formed. Our local guide will point out sights along the Freedom Trail, Back Bay, Beacon Hill and the gold-dome State House. There will be time to stroll the Public Gardens and as well as free time for lunch and shopping at the historic Quincy Market and Faneuil Hall. Later we will check-in at the Southbridge Hotel before visiting the Historical Salem Cross Inn. Settle in as their baker prepares a deep-dish apple pie from scratch right before your eyes, using apples picked from the trees in Boston's local orchards. Then, let the fireplace feast begin! Enjoy some of New England's best meals and enjoy the evening.

Day 7: Friday September 23, 2022 – Depart Boston (B)

Today we will enjoy an included breakfast then begin our journey home. We will return to our original pickup points with sand in our shoes, seashells in our pockets and memories in our hearts of an amazing trip to Cape Cod!
