On our final day, we'll travel to Gravenhurst for a steamship cruise on Lake Muskoka. Make sure you pack your cameras as we take in the best fall splendour and beauty that Ontario has to offer!

OUR ITINERARY

Day 1: Monday, October 3, 2022 (L)

Join our motor coach this morning at one of our pre-determined pickup locations before heading North! We'll make a stop at Spectacle Lake Lodge for an included smokehouse style lunch before heading into Algonquin Park - Ontario's first and largest Provincial Park. While in Algonquin, we'll visit the Logging Museum to learn more about the history of the area. Be sure to keep your eyes peeled for moose and listen for loons as we make our way through the towering pines and rich fall colours! After our drive through Algonquin, we'll make our way to Deerhurst Resort where we will check in for the next two nights. The evening will be at leisure to grab dinner (on your own).

Day 2: Tuesday, October 4, 2022 (B, D)

This morning we'll have an included breakfast at the resort before heading out for a day of exploring. This morning we will take a walking tour to learn more about the Group of Seven's paintings and history in the area. We will then head to the Lion's Lookout in Huntsville to view the expansive landscape and fall foliage from a high up vantage point. After the lookout you'll have time for lunch on your own. This afternoon we'll visit Sugarbush Hill Maple Syrup Farm for a short tour and tasting. Afterwards, we'll make our way to the Rotary Village Train Station & Steam Museum where we will get to explore the museum and ride on the Portage Flyer Train! This evening we'll return to the hotel to enjoy an included group dinner. The rest of your day will be at leisure to enjoy the resorts amenities or to relax and take in the beautiful surroundings!

Day 3: Wednesday, October 5, 2022 (B, L)

This morning we will have an included breakfast at the hotel before checking out and making our way to Gravenhurst - also known as "The Gateway to Muskoka". Here we will board a Muskoka Steamship Cruise for an incredible lunch cruise to view the fall colours from the water - you'll want to be sure to have your camera ready! After our cruise, we'll begin our journey home where you will be returned to your original pickup locations and bid farewell to new and old friends!
