DAY-BY-DAY ITINERARY

Day 1: Aug 29, 2021 - Depart for Vancouver (B)

Arrive in Vancouver and transfer to the Pinnacle Hotel. Admission to the Vancouver Lookout is included today where you can get a 360° view of one of the most beautiful cities in the world. Dinner on your own tonight!

Day 2: Aug 30, 2021 - Vancouver (B)

After breakfast, board a comfortable motorcoach for a sightseeing tour of Vancouver's spectacular North Shore. Highlights include the Capilano Suspension Bridge and the Grouse Mountain Skyride where we will get breathtaking views of the city, ocean and the surrounding mountains. We will spend another night in Vancouver.

Day 3: Aug 31, 2021 - Vancouver to Kamloops (B,L)

Today we will board the Rocky Mountaineer and travel from Vancouver to Kamloops, in the heart of British Columbia. You will see dramatic changes in scenery, from the lush green fields of the Fraser Valley, through forests and winding river canyons surrounded by the peaks of the Coast and Cascade Mountains, to the desert-like environment of the BC Interior. Highlights include Hell's Gate in the Fraser Canyon and the steep slopes along the Thompson River. Breakfast & lunch are included onboard. Your day concludes when the Rocky Mountaineer arrives in Kamloops this evening. Spend the evening exploring the city or relaxing in your room.

Day 4: Sep 1, 2021 - Kamloops to Banff (B,L)

Early this morning, you will be transferred by motorcoach to the station from your hotel. Board the Rocky Mountaineer train at the Kamloops Station to continue your journey east through the mighty Canadian Rockies into the province of Alberta. Travel across ranch lands, along rocky lakeshores, over high mountain passes and through the remarkable tunnels that form part of the rich rail history of the Canadian Rockies. Breakfast & lunch are included onboard. Highlights include Craigellachie, the climb over Rogers Pass, the Kicking Horse Canyon, and the Spiral Tunnels. Arrive in Banff this evening at the Banff Caribou Lodge located on Banff Avenue.

Day 5: Sep 2, 2021 - Banff (B,D)

Breakfast at Hotel. Depart by motorcoach for your full-day tour of Banff and Yoho National Park. Yoho National Park offers magnificent natural wonders like the Spiral Tunnels, the turquoise serene waters of Emerald Lake and a natural Rock Bridge spanning the Kicking Horse River. We will also stop at Lake Louise for group photos! Group dinner tonight at our hotel - the Banff Caribou Lodge.

Day 6: Sep 3, 2021- Icefields Parkway (B)

After breakfast, board your private motorcoach and enjoy a full day sightseeing tour along the magnificent Icefields Parkway. Among the highlights are Bow Lake, Athabasca Falls and the Columbia Icefields. It is here you will ride a unique Ice Explorer onto the Athabasca Glacier and learn more about its geological features. We will also visit the Glacier Skywalk - consisting of a 400 metre interpretive boardwalk and a glass-floored observation platform extending 30m out over the Sunwapta Valley. Tonight is our last night in Banff.

Day 7: Sep 4, 2021 - Banff to Calgary (B)

Breakfast at hotel. Depart by private motorcoach for your full day sightseeing tour in Banff. Ride the Banff Gondola to the top of Sulphur Mountain for 360-degree views of the town of Banff and its surrounding mountains. Learn about how life in the West once was at Canada's largest living history museum, the Heritage Park Historical Village. Afterwards head to Calgary where we will spend our final night. Admission to the Calgary Tower is included.

Day 8: Sep 5, 2021 - Calgary to Toronto (B)

Group Breakfast at hotel. Depart for Calgary Airport to board our flights back to Toronto where we will be greeted by our coach to return us to our original starting points!

Book now with a \$250 refundable deposit. A secondary deposit of \$500 is due on Dec 1, 2020 at which point all payments become non-refundable. Final payment due June 11, 2021. Cancellation insurance is recommended - please call office for pricing. Prices are subject to change based on airfare costs. A valid Canadian passport is required for this tour.
